

The Venue is Moving

The Church, Lakeland Center, Ball Park
Open Field, to The Tent of Meeting with God



The Tent Vision of William Branham

LAKELAND, FL — The Venue for revival will change in Lakeland starting on Memorial Day. Todd Bentley and Fresh Fire Ministries in conjunction with Ignited Assembly of God and Pastor Stephen Strader will establish a permanent venue

for the summer at Lakeland Linder Regional Airport.

A beautiful new 10,000 seat Clear Span Structure tent will be air-conditioned and will begin to be the permanent structure for the revival as well as Ignited Church.

This will be the third move in 53 days of revival. The incredible growth has been massive over the past three weeks. At first the revival had a normal growth at Ignited Assembly of God but when the Fire Marshall of Lakeland gave an ultimatum to the revival to trim the huge crowd, the venue had it first change to the Lakeland Center. On its first night the capacity went from 700 to 7,000 as every seat was filled. Another problem seemed to loom for

the revival crowd as the weekends at the Lakeland Center forced the Pastor Steven Strader to move to the Detroit Tigers Spring Training Complex where the crowd increased to more than 9,000. During the weekdays the revival moved back to the

Lakeland Center but the following weekend saw the revival move to the open field at Lakeland's Linder Airport. This move was much like the great move of God in England as John Wesley preached in the open fields because religion excluded him from the church. These three moves to support the new move of God has been done flawlessly and has accommodated the faith full as they sought the powerful move of God.

The awesome move of God has called upon a small church and evangelic ministry to shift and move with no more than a day's preparation at each change. As long as there was a venue the hungry showed up with the sick, the lost and the injured.

This move is not going to be cheap for the revival on Friday Todd Bentley told the huge crowd and those watching by internet and television the story of the cost of what have been going on for the last five weeks. Bentley said that the revival had already spent more than 2,000,000 dollars in the last 50 days. The evangelist said that there was no greater place to sew a seed of faith than revival. The new facility will house the revival for the

entire summer and could possibly be the permanent place for the duration of revival. The new tent that will hold what is now called the overflow, but if the growth continues as it has; the tent could be smaller than needed. Bentley spoke about the Lakeland Center and said one day of revival costs more that \$35,000 to \$50,000 a day just to keep the building open and pay the expense of utilities and rent. He spoke to people and asked for revivalist to help all over the world to pay for the new structure that will cost more than \$750,000.

Paul Keith Davis and Pastor Steven Shelley of Phenix City, Alabama are both students of revival.
